**California Senate Recognizes National Engineers Week and National Surveyors Week with Resolutions**

**SACRAMENTO** – The California Senate recognized both National Engineers Week and National Surveyors Week with separate resolutions, on Thursday, Feb. 5, in Sacramento. Sen. John Benoit, R-Bermuda Dunes, presented SR 11, a resolution recognizing National Surveyors Week (held this year from March 15-21), while Sen. Alex Padilla, D-San Fernando, presented SR 10 to recognize National Engineers Week (held this year from Feb. 15-21). Both resolutions passed unanimously.

SR 10 and SR 11 spotlight the wide range of contributions that engineers and surveyors make in all aspects of modern society. ACEC California President Bill Green was on the Senate floor for the presentation of both resolutions.
