Background: A. Kay Stanfield Spinks is the first African-American female jurist to serve in Oakland County, Michigan. A member of the State Bar of Michigan since 1977, her professional experiences include service as the first female attorney and Senior Assistant General Counsel of the Southeastern Michigan Transportation Authority; Partner in the law firm of Robinson, Washington, Smith and Stanfield, P.C.; Of Counsel to the law firm of Morgan and McClarty, P.C.; Of Counsel to the law firm of Sherbow and Mitchell, P.C.; Oakland County Circuit Court Research Attorney; Special Assistant Attorney General for the State of Michigan, and Acting Director/Consultant and faculty member for the American Institute for Paralegal Studies, Inc. Ms. Stanfield Spinks has also served as a certified mediator, arbitrator and facilitator and is a member of the Commercial Panel of the American Arbitration Association. Professional highlights include successful facilitation of the \$2 Billion Bloomfield Park mixed-use land development litigation and service as Chairperson of the Bloomfield Park Joint Development Council.

A staunch supporter of education, Ms. Stanfield Spinks also developed the law student scholarship fund administered by the Straker Bar Foundation and established an endowed memorial scholarship at Wayne State University. She has served as a mentor to many undergraduate and law students, and received an award for outstanding service as a mentor from the University of Michigan.

Ms. Stanfield Spinks attended the Honors College and received her Bachelor of Arts degree from the University of Michigan in 1974, and her law degree from Michigan in 1977. She also engaged in postgraduate study at Harvard University Law School.
